

WHITE RIVER TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING
APRIL 14, 2020, 7 PM

The regular meeting of the White River Township was called to order at 7:00 pm by Supervisor Mike Cockerill.

Roll Call: Mike Cockerill, Supervisor; Patti Sargent, Clerk; Deb Harris, Treasurer; Laura Anderson, Trustee. Bob Suits, Trustee by phone.

1. Approval of Agenda. Motion by Harris to approve agenda as written, supported by Anderson. Aye: all. Nay: none. Motion passed.

2. Approval of March 11, 2020 regular board meeting minutes. Motion by Harris to approve minutes as written, supported by Anderson to approve. Aye: all. Nay: none. Motion passed.

3. Accounts Payable. Motion by Suits to pay accounts payable as submitted, supported by Anderson. Roll Call: Harris aye, Sargent: aye, Suits: aye, Anderson: aye, Cockerill: aye. Motion passed.

4. Correspondence: Kent letter response sent; Walton letter sent to attorney.

5. Reports: A) Financial: Noted

6. Unfinished Business: All unfinished business will be covered when the State "Stay at Home" order has been lifted.

7. New Business:

A). Resolution 56-2020 allowing the township to cancel meetings during "Stay at Home" orders. Harris put forth the motion to adopt resolution 56-2020 as written, Anderson supported the motion. Roll call vote: Suits aye, Sargent: aye, Harris: aye, Anderson: aye, Cockerill, aye Nays: 0. Resolution adopted.

B). Resolution 57-2020: Headlee rollback and millage for August election, which will increase property taxes by 0.2491 mills to restore a portion of the millage rate to 1 mill per \$1000. Sargent put forth the motion to approve resolution 57-2020 as written. Harris supported the motion. Roll call vote: Suits aye, Sargent: aye, Harris: aye, Anderson: aye, Cockerill, aye Nays: 0. Resolution adopted.

C) All building permit approvals have been delayed due to the stay at home order by the State of Michigan.

D) There has been some concern expressed by several White River Township residents that the Dune Sanctuary is now difficult to access. A letter will be written to the Muskegon County Road Commission to increase accessibility for residents with possible changes to the rock revetment at the end of Ferry Street.
