

*Adopted 8.13.2019*

WRT Township will consider **shoreline** special exceptions using rip rap or natural materials if:

1. The structural integrity of the house and or infrastructure is compromised due to erosion and it cannot be moved back
2. There is a pre-existing, permitted wall that has resurfaced from the past
3. In all special exceptions the applicant will need to have permission from the neighbors
4. The old existing groins/jettys are removed
5. Does the applicant have enough room to move the home back away from the shore? If yes, that should be the first consideration.
