ORDINANCE TO REPEAL THE **EARLIER ORDINANCE** (ORDINANCE NO. 57-2023) TO **IMPOSE TEMPORARY** MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF ANY ZONING APPROVALS, REZONINGS, PERMITS, LICENSES OR APPROVALS FOR SOLAR FARMS AND SOLAR PANELS (AS WELL AS CONSTRUCTING, CREATING OR INSTALLING SUCH ITEMS).

THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITE RIVER (the "Township") ORDAINS:

Section 1. Repeal. Ordinance No. 57-2023 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency ordinance and shall become effective upon the expiration of 7 days following its publication (or a summary hereof) in a newspaper of general circulation within the Township.
